DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This label must be in the possession of the user at the time of pesticide application. Follow all applicable directions, restrictions, Worker Protection Standard requirements, and precautions on the EPA registered label.

Used as directed below, Sencor DF 75% will reduce competition from downy brome (*Bromus tectorum*) in timothy hay fields.

CROP	RATE LB. SENCOR® DF/A	APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS
Timothy Hay ¹	1/4 to 3/8	Apply specified dosage per acre by air or ground only to dormant established stands. Use the lower rate where Bromus competition is less severe and/or the weed is treated pre-emergence to the 5-leaf stage. Use the higher rate for higher populations and/or larger weeds. Allow at least 28 days between application and cutting.

¹ Established stands only. Established stands are those which have been harvested at least one time prior to treatment.

RESTRICTIONS/PRECAUTIONS:

Do not apply this product to timothy hay fields through any type of irrigation system.

Do not apply more than 1 application per acre per year.

Do not apply on soils with less than 1.5 organic matter or to soils with pH of 7.5 or higher or excessive injury will occur.

MIXING: Sencor DF 75% is compatible with most fertilizers, fungicides and insecticides. Sencor DF 75% may be combined with other registered and recommended herbicides for enhanced weed control. Before mixing with another herbicide, consult both product labels and a knowledgeable authority or Bayer CropScience representative.
