DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Follow all applicable directions, restrictions, Worker Protection Standard requirements and precautions on the EPA-registered label. This labeling must be in the possession of the user at the time of pesticide application.

RADISH: (SEED CROP ONLY -- but do not use on the Daikon Radish variety)

Apply 1 lb. *Orthene* 97 per application per acre in 10 to 60 gallons of spray mix by ground as a broadcast application or in 5 to 10 gallons of spray mix by air.

RESTRICTIONS/PRECAUTIONS

1. Do not feed crop residues to livestock or allow animals to graze treated areas.
2. Do not apply more than 2 lb. product (2 lb. a.i./A) per year.
3. For repeat application, user must allow a minimum of 7 days between applications.
4. Do not apply using low pressure handwand equipment.
5. All radish (other than daikon) seed screenings shall be disposed of in such a way that they cannot be distributed or used for food or feed. The seed conditioner shall keep records of screening disposal for three years from the date of disposal and shall furnish the records to the WSDA forthwith upon request. Disposal records shall consist of documentation from a controlled dumpsite, incinerator, or other equivalent disposal site and shall show the lot numbers, amount of material disposed of, its grower(s) and the date of disposal.
6. No portion of the radish (other than daikon) seed plant, including but not limited to green chop, hay, pellets, meal, whole seed, cracked seed, roots, bulbs, leaves and seed screenings, may be used or distributed for food or feed purposes.
7. Radish (other than daikon) seed shall bear a tag or container label which forbids use of the seed for human consumption or animal feed.
8. Radish (other than daikon) seed may not be distributed for human consumption or animal feed.
9. For use under this SLN, do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on blooming crops or broadleaf weeds. Do not apply this product to blooming radish seed during the pollination period: apply as a pre-bloom spray, or apply at the end of the pollination period. Bee colonies used for pollination should be removed from the field being treated prior to the application. Notify beekeepers pollinating crops within 1/4 mile of the field to be treated at least 48 hours prior to the application.

WSDA Container Disposal Guidance: Completely empty the contents of the paper container into application equipment and apply to a labeled crop or site. The empty container may be disposed of in a sanitary landfill. Burning is not a legal method of container disposal in Washington.
